



Gungho Dogs Puppy Purchase Health Guarantee

THE FIRST THREE DAYS

The first health guarantee we offer applies to the 72 hours after you pick up your dog. At time of pickup all the dogs have received vaccinations, dewormings, and veterinary inspections. Immunizations will NOT be needed within the first 7-day vet visit. Gungho Dogs instructs you to have your dog inspected by a veterinarian within the first 72 hours. If the designated time for a veterinarian visit lapses and the buyer fails to take the puppy, they acknowledge that the puppy was in good health at the time of purchase. However, if the veterinarian discovers any significant health issues with the puppy, the buyer can return the puppy along with the vet report for a full refund of the purchase price or a puppy of equal value from the next available litter (if available). The buyer is aware that they must not take the puppy to public places until it has received its final rounds of shots, as determined by a licensed veterinarian, usually at 16 weeks of age. This is for the puppy's health and to avoid contact with areas where infected or unvaccinated dogs may have been present, causing illnesses such as parvovirus, giardia, clostridia, coccidian, etc. Any illnesses the puppy contracts from the buyer's failure to follow these guidelines will void the guarantee.

TWO YEAR HEALTH GUARANTEE

Gungho Dogs stands behind the health of our dogs by offering a two year non-transferable health guarantee under the conditions that the buyer agrees to: (a) not allow the puppy to run on asphalt or concrete for the first year and (b) feed the approved diet consisting of Purina Pro Plan 30/20 Performance with weekly dog probiotics. In the event that the puppy is diagnosed with a genetic or congenital disorder that is life-threatening or significantly impacts its quality of life within 24 months of its birthdate and is verified by a veterinarian, the buyer has the option of:

- Receiving a replacement puppy from the next available litter of similar gender, color, breed, and generation or a comparable color, breed, and generation if one is available, or

- Receiving monetary reimbursement for veterinary expenses related to the treatment of the disorder, up to the purchase price of the puppy, excluding food expenses. The buyer must provide paid veterinary bills to the seller within 30 days of incurring the charges and the seller will pay the refund at their discretion, no later than from the next subsequent litter bred.

Gungho Dogs requires that veterinarian documentation be sent to them by the buyer within 30 days of any diagnoses made. The original dog doesn't need to be returned, but if the buyer wants to give it up, they must return it to the breeder.

What's Covered:

For 24 months from the date of birth, Gungho Dogs offers a warranty for:

- Hip or elbow dysplasia caused by genetics (as long as the puppy hasn't been overweight or exposed to unhealthy conditions, trauma, abuse, or any physical injury of unknown origin)
- Eye disorders requiring surgery or medication diagnosed by a veterinary ophthalmologist
- Cardiac (heart) disorders requiring surgery or life-long medication diagnosed by a canine cardiologist

What's Not Covered:

This warranty does not cover illnesses caused by viral infections, improper bites, hernias, hypoglycemia, worms, giardia, coccidiosis, or foreign object ingestion. It also does not cover illnesses from unknown causes, trauma, abuse, or failure to maintain general health, as well as injury to joints or bones from over-exercise or exposure to improper or harsh environments. The warranty also excludes health problems caused by overweight or improper nutrition, as well as abuse, accident, negligence, or misuse. The seller is not liable for any damages resulting from the dog. All refunds are cumulative and once the full purchase price of the puppy has been reimbursed, the warranties expire and the seller has no further obligation. The buyer must provide veterinary records if requesting a refund or replacement.

Buyer Responsibilities:

- Within 7 days of receiving the puppy from Gungho Dogs, take it to a licensed vet for a wellness checkup. No vaccinations will be needed as they will already have been given by 8 weeks of age. The buyer will be informed of the vaccination schedule and the next

due dates. Note that repeat vaccinations at the puppy check may void the health guarantees as over-vaccination can cause health problems and even death.

- Follow a routine of preventative health care which includes, but is not limited to, vaccinations, parasite control, monthly heartworm prevention and other preventative medication
- Provide quality food and fresh water at all daily feeding times
- Avoid making the dog overweight or over-exercising it
- Protect the dog from harsh environmental conditions such as sleeping on hard surfaces or prolonged exposure to extreme temperatures or weather
- Do not keep the dog outside overnight
- Provide minimum basic obedience training
- Contact the seller before rehoming the dog, the seller has the first right of refusal
- Never abandon the dog at a shelter or rescue.

Failure to comply with any of the above will void this warranty.
